"the majority decided that we should sail..." (vs. 12)

We rely on _____

"When a gentle south wind began to blow, they thought they had obtained what they wanted..." (vs. 13)

II DETERMINE _____

Ask:

HOW TO DEAL WITH DIFFICULTY

"These little troubles, which are temporary, are winning for us a permanent, glorious and solid reward all out of proportion to our pain." 2 Cor. 4:17 (Ph)

Wrong Responses

"To Drift"

"... so we gave way to it and were driven along" (vs 15)

"To Discard:

"... they began to throw the cargo overboard..." (vs 18)

"To Despair"

"... we finally gave up all hope of being saved." (vs 20)
